August 12, 1914 - June 15, 2011

Julia V. Healy, age 96, of Dixon, died Wednesday, June 15, 2011 at Dixon Healthcare Center. She was born August 12, 1914, in Dixon, the daughter of Adam and Julia (Szarvas) Gabany.
