Louis E. Grasser age 76 of Amboy died Thursday Oct. 22, 2009 at the Illinois Veterans Home in LaSalle. He was born Feb. 9 1933 in McNabb, IL the son of Ralph L. and Marjorie (Morgensen) Grasser. He was raised on a farm in the rural McNabb area and farmed in the McNabb-Varna area. He worked for the US Post Office on the Chicago - Omaha train. He worked as a Standard Oil agent in Henry then in 1962 was transferred to Amboy in the same capacity. He was also an installation technician for Contel Telephone Co. (Verizon) for 24 years, retiring in 1993. He was a combat veteran of the US Army during the Korean War. He was an E.M.T. and Fireman for both the Amboy and Sublette Fire Departments. He was a certified umpire in baseball, and registered in basketball with the IHSA. He officiated both sports at the Little League, high school, college, and Legion levels for many years. He umpired professional minor league baseball in the Midwest and Carolina Leagues. He was an honorary official of the IHSA. He was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church in Nachusa, serving the Lutheran church in many capacities. He was a member of the VFW, the 25th Infantry Association, the Combat Infantryman Association, and American Legion, serving as an honor guard. He married Hetta Baker at the Emmaus Lutheran Church in McNabb July 18, 1952. He was preceded in death by his parents and a granddaughter Lisa Ann Nauman.
