



## Louis Franklin Ohlendorf

April 26, 1928 - October 13, 2014

Dr. Louis F. Ohlendorf, DVM, age 86, of Amboy, died Monday, Oct. 13, 2014, at Aperion Care of Amboy. He was born April 26, 1928 in Ottawa, IL the son of George and Frances (Fishburn) Ohlendorf. He owned and operated Amboy Veterinarian Clinic from 1954 until his retirement in 1995. He was a graduate of the University of Illinois and served in the Marine Corps. He was a founding member of Shady Oaks Country Club and was a member of the Amboy Lions Club, the Masons, and the Amboy American Legion Post. He served on the Amboy School Board and participated as a member of and Past President of the Amboy Hospital Board.

He married Norma Frandin Aug. 7, 1953 at the First Methodist Church in Rockford.

He is survived by his wife Norma, children Jeff Ohlendorf of Mendota, Barb (Tim) McLaughlin of Rockford, Greg (Patricia) Ohlendorf of Amboy, Steve Ohlendorf of Dixon, Amy Yost of Rensselaer, NY, 13 grandchildren and 16 great grandchildren, and one brother Earl Ohlendorf of Naplate, IL.

He was preceded in death by a son Michael Robert Ohlendorf, brothers Melvin and Robert Ohlendorf and sisters Shirley Heath, Mildred Charles and Beverly Ohlendorf.
