January 21, 1930 - November 6, 2015

Marian Faye Glenn, age 85, of Dixon, died Friday November 6, 2015 following an extended illness. The eldest of three children, she was born on January 21, 1930, in Peterstown, LaSalle County, Illinois to Vesta and Lorraine (Moody) Pasley. Following graduation from Lee Center High School, Marian lived in Mendota, Illinois, where she served as bookkeeper for a local business until her marriage on September 17, 1948, to Howard Glenn of Amboy. As a young bride, Marian worked closely with her husband operating Glenn's Grocery Store and Drive-In, and following the sale of their family business Marian devoted her life full time to the role of wife and mother. They made their home in Amboy for well over 50 years before moving to Dixon ten years ago in order to be closer to their three children, Laura (Thomas) Palmer, Michael Glenn and Mark (Julie) Glenn. Marian was a woman of great faith, demonstrating this same faith through her prayers, devotion, and service to others as teacher, counselor, confidant, and friend.

Survivors include her husband of 67 years, her three children, twelve grandchildren, thirteen great-grandchildren, and one sister Hazel (Gail) Gonigam. Preceding her in death were her parents; one brother, Donald, and one grandson Andrew.

Visitation will be held from 12:00 noon to 2:00 PM, on Wednesday, November 11, 2015, at the United First Church of Amboy. The funeral will be held at 2:00 PM, immediately following the time of visitation, with burial at the Prairie Repose Cemetery in Amboy. A memorial has been established to Serenity
