March 24, 1917 - September 21, 2012

Marian Hinrichs age 95 formerly of Amboy and has lived many years in Dixon passed away Friday September 21, 2012 at Good Samaritan Society – Prophets Riverview Nursing Home in Prophetstown, IL. Marian Lucille McCracken Hinrichs was born March 24, 1917 to Lee and Muriel (Trout) McCracken in Detroit, MI. Since the age of 11 months has been a resident of Lee County. She was preceded in death by her parents, one son Shelby Hinrichs, one sister Maxine Faley, 2 brothers Donald Lee and Kenneth McCracken and one grandson. She graduated from Amboy High School in 1933, later attended Scoville's Business College in Sterling. In 1934 was crowned Miss Lee County Country Life in Amboy. She was past president of the Amboy Women's Club and the Lee County Women's Club. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Dixon. She was past president of Wa-Tan-Ye, United Methodist Women and Church Women United. She was a former member of the Dixon Women's Club and volunteered at the Reagan Home. She served 15 years as president of the Friendship Club at Countryside Manor where she resided since 1979. Marian was the former owner of the Mar-Lou Shop in Amboy and later worked at Kaleel's Clothing in Amboy, Klines and the Vogue Shop of Dixon. She also worked at Orchard Glen Nursing Home for 6 years and 20 years at the Dixon State School as a technician in pediatrics in the hospital. She is survived by 2 children, Gary (Ann) Hinrichs of Freeport, IL and Shery Lewey of Tampico, 9 grandchildren and 15 great grandchildren. Cremation rites have been

accorded. Burial of cremains will be at a later date in Prairie Repose Cemetery in Amboy.
