Marlene M. Weippert age 85 of Dixon died on June 10, 2021, at Franklin Grove Living and Rehab. She was born on Dec. 31, 1935, in Munich, Germany, the daughter of Franz and Margarete (Bruckner) Schull. Marlene worked as a bookkeeper in Germany before coming to the US. Marlene met Kurt in 1961 while he was on vacation in Germany. They continued to correspond with each other for the next 2 years before Marlene came over to the US.

Marlene married Kurt Weippert on July 6, 1963, in Sterling, IL, and they shared 58 years of marriage together.

Marlene worked as a bookkeeper and later as a homemaker prior to her retirement. She was a member of the Knights of Columbus Auxiliary. She is preceded in death by her parents, and 1 sister Hannelore Boshaar. Marlene is survived by her husband Kurt, son Lawrence (Lynn) Weippert of Palatine, IL, grandson Jacob Weippert, and brother Hugo (Ilse) Schull of Germany.
