Mary Ann Koenig, age 69, of Dixon, died Wednesday, July 30, 2014, in her home following a long battle with kidney and lung failure. She was born in Amboy, November 24, 1944, the daughter of James and Genevieve (Cotter) Thompson.

She was preceded in death by her parents; 1 brother William J. "Bill" Thompson.

Survivors include her husband; 2 sons Brett (Stephanie) Koenig of Deer Park, and Michael Koenig of East Dundee; 2 grandsons Tommy and Nicholas.
