Mary L. Welty, age 91, of Amboy, died Sunday August 3, 2014, at Green Acres Healthcare and Rehabilitation Center in Amboy. She was born February 24, 1923, in Lick Creek, the daughter of Delmar and Merle (Neeley) Sitter. She had been the Activities Director for Dixon State School prior to her retirement. She was also Music Director at Clipper Kiddies in Amboy, and had been Choir Director at First Baptist Church in Dixon.

Mary was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Amboy. Her life was devoted to her husband, children, grandchildren, and her music.

She married Robert D. Welty January 2, 1942, in Dixon. Her preceded her in death January 21, 2008. She was also preceded in death by a great-great grandson Eli Christoffersen; her brother Eugene Sitter; son-in-law John C. Anderson; daughter-in-law Mary A. Welty.
