Maurice B. "Mo" Swinton age 97 formerly of Dixon died May 17, 2023 in Southlake, TX. He was born Dec. 20, 1925 near Nashua, IA the son of Fred and Hattie (Knutson) Swinton and grew up on a dairy farm as 1 of 14 siblings. He attended Swinton Country School and graduated from Nashua High School where he lettered in football and basketball. After high school he entered the Army serving in WWII. Mo had worked for Commonwealth Edison for 33 years prior to his retirement in 1988. He was a member of St Patrick Catholic Church, Knights of Columbus Council 690, and IBEW.

Mo married Alice Stover Aug. 4, 1951 in Dixon. She preceded him in death Oct. 31, 2020. He was also preceded in death by brothers Harold, Willard, Donald, Dale, Roger, Herbert and Vernon Swinton and sisters Mildred Schultz, Doris White, Wilma Braend, Helen Mae Ascher and Alfreeda Albaugh.

Mo is survived by one son Michael (DeAnn) Swinton of Southlake, TX, one grandson Matthew (Courtney) Swinton, one great grandson Miles and one sister Lois Brodt. Mo was extremely proud of his grandson Matthew and his great grandson Miles.

Mass of Christian Burial will be on Wednesday July 26, 2023 at 10:30 AM at St Patrick Catholic Church in Dixon. Burial of cremains with Military Honors will follow at Oakwood Cemetery in Dixon.
