Michael P. Pasley, age 47, of Dixon, died Sunday March 23, 2014, at KSB Hospital in Dixon. He was born August 30, 1966, in Mexico, MO, the son of James Gordon and Margaret (Becker) Pasley.

Mike was a Social Studies Teacher at Amboy High School for the past 10 years where he had coached basketball and baseball and served as a Senior Class Advisor. He was also the P.A. Announcer for Amboy High School Football and Basketball games. He worked at Quincy Medical Group and was a fixture at Quincy Notre Dame High School. He coached Dixon Dynamite Girls Fast Pitch 10u and 14u teams and volunteered with the Dixon YMCA Dolphin Swim Team. Mike loved watching his daughters' many extracurricular activities.

Mike was a member of the IEA.

He wrote sports articles for the Moline Dispatch, the Quincy Herald Whig, and Sauk Valley Newspapers.

He married Sara Hartl at St. Peter Catholic Church in Quincy August 10, 1996.

Survivors include his wife; 4 daughters Erin, Elise, Erica, and Emeri, all at home; his parents of Quincy; 2 brothers Kevin Pasley of Reno, NV; and Alan (Tracy) Pasley of Springfield; 1 sister Annette (Michael) Bruns of Quincy.
