



## Michael Streit

January 4, 1950 - September 26, 2010

Michael P. Streit, age 60, of Sublette, died Sunday September 26, 2010 in his home following a long battle with cancer. He was born January 4, 1950 in Spring Valley, Illinois, the son of Floyd and Florence (Jaegle) Streit. He was a life long farmer in the Maytown area and also owned and operated Quality Construction at Woodhaven Lakes in Sublette for 30 years. He was a Sergeant in the Illinois National Guard in the late 1960's. He married Rebeca Del Socorro Vazquez in Dixon June 1, 2007. He was preceded in death by his parents.
