Norma J. Ohlendorf, age 82, of Amboy, died Tuesday, July 28, 2015, at Franklin Grove Health and Rehab Center. She was born June 15, 1933, in Ottawa, the daughter of Charles and Marie (Halterman) Frandin.

Norma was involved in the Parent Teacher Association; she was a member of Amboy Theater Group and served as a Trustee on the Prairie Repose Cemetery Board.

As a member of Shady Oaks Country Club she enjoyed time as a member and former President of the Shady Oaks Woman's Association; who referred to themselves as the Shady Ladies.

Norma shared her artistic talent by gifting her family, friends and community with handmade tee shirts, afghans, crocheted items, oil painting and charcoal drawings. Some of her work may be seen at Amboy City Hall and Amboy Depot Museum.

She married Dr. Louis F. Ohlendorf in Rockford, August 7, 1953. He preceded her in death October 13, 2014. She was also preceded in death by her son Michael R. Ohlendorf; 2 brothers Charles and Richard Frandin; 1 sister Mary Sapp.

Survivors include her children Jeff Ohlendorf of Mendota, Barb (Tim) McLaughlin of Rockford, Greg (Patricia) Ohlendorf of Amboy, Steve Ohlendorf of Dixon, Amy Yost of Rensselaer, NY; 13 grandchildren and 17 great grandchildren.

A private family service will be held at Prairie Repose Cemetery. A Celebration of Life will be held Sun. August 16, from 1:00 until 4:00 PM, at the Amboy Community Building.
