



Paul Maxell Nusbaum

February 8, 1927 - November 21, 2015

Paul M. Nusbaum, age 88, of Dixon, died peacefully Saturday, November 21, 2015, at OSF St. Francis Medical Center in Peoria surrounded by his family. He was born in Glen Elder, KS, February 8, 1927, the son of Harvey and Mabel (Hendricks) Nusbaum.

Paul was a lifelong farmer, and also was a Lieutenant for the Dixon Police Department for 20 years prior to his retirement. He was a Veteran of the Army. He was a member of St. Patrick Catholic Church in Dixon, the Knights of Columbus Council 690, and the Dixon Elks Lodge.

Paul married Patricia Devine on November 12, 1949, at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Dixon.

He was preceded in death by his parents; 2 daughters Jill Kathleen and Joyce Ann Nusbaum; 6 brothers and 5 sisters.

Survivors include his wife; a son Paul (Stephanie) Nusbaum of West Des Moines, IA; a daughter Kimberly (Eric) Gierahn of Rochester, MI; 4 grandchildren Ellen (Matt) Wertz, Emmet Nusbaum, and Sean and Ryan Gierahn; 1 sister Joyce Baker of Charlotte, NC; many nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, November 25, beginning with a 9:00 AM prayer service in the Jones Funeral Home in Dixon followed by a 9:30 AM Mass of Christian Burial at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Dixon with the Rev. Bernard Sehr, Pastor, officiating. Burial will follow in Oakwood Cemetery in Dixon with Military Honors provided by the Dixon Combined Veterans Group.
