Phyllis Catherine Barnes, age 99, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, March 5, 2025, at Miller's Merry Manor in Plymouth, Indiana. Born on August 13, 1925, in Chicago, Illinois, she was the cherished daughter of William "Bill" Sylvester Klos and Catherine Gertrude (Ryan) Klos.

Her quiet acts of kindness and generosity shone through in every role she undertook.
