



## Ralph Roemmich

March 23, 1918 - February 18, 2012

Ralph F. Roemmich, age 93, of Mendota, and formerly of Sublette, died Saturday February 18, 2012 at Heritage Health in Mendota. He was born in Sublette March 23, 1918, the son of Henry and Sadie (Schamberger) Roemmich. He was a 4th generation farmer on the same land in the Sublette area until his retirement. Ralph was a Veteran of the Army during World War II, and participated in the Honor Flight in 2010. He was a member of St. Paul Evangelical Church and the St. Paul Cemetery Board; he was also a member of the Sublette Grain Elevator Board. He married Ethel Richards May 20, 1941. She preceded him in death March 3, 2004. He was also preceded in death by 2 daughters Marilyn Roemmich and Nancy Williams; 2 sisters Esther Zimmerlein and Florence Daehler; 1 brother Wilson Roemmich. Survivors include a son Richard (Bernie) Roemmich of Sublette; 6 grandchildren Deborah (Kevin) Schultz, Denna (Brent) Barker, Dixie (Barry) Doughty, Denise (Tip) Coffin, Melissa (Kenneth) Johnson, and Brian (Lauren) Williams; 7 great-grandchildren; 2 sisters Gertrude Fitzgerald of Mendota, and Lillian (Melvin) Monson of Rockford. Cremation rites have been accorded. Memorial services will be held on Friday, February 24, 2012, at 11:00 AM in the First United Methodist Church in Mendota, with the Rev. Michael Morrell, Pastor, officiating. Burial of cremains will be at 2:00 PM in Prairie Repose Cemetery in Amboy with Military Graveside Rites by the Amboy American Legion. Visitation will be on Friday from 10:00 AM until time of service in the church. In lieu of flowers, a memorial has been established
