Robert F Dickinson age 79 of Amboy died Thursday June 22, 2006 at Amboy Rehab. & Nursing Center. He was born Aug. 21, 1926 in Amboy the son of Oliver and Myrcella (Carroll) Dickinson. He was preceded in death by his parents, 2 brothers Harold Carroll and Charles Dickinson and 2 sisters Harriet Dickinson and Jane Dickinson Gehant, one nephew William Dickinson and one great niece Traci Mihm. He is survived by 2 brothers Oliver A (Eileen) Dickinson of Amboy and James (Geri) Dickinson of Dixon and sister in law Mary (Charles) Dickinson of Amboy, 14 nieces and nephews, 45 great nieces and nephews, 47 great great nieces and nephews. Bob "Cupe" Dickinson graduated from St. Anne's Grade School and Amboy High School. He enlisted in the Army after he graduated from Amboy High School in 1945. Bob worked at various businesses in the local area retiring from HWI in Dixon several years ago. Bob was an active member of the American Legion. Bob "Cupe" gave new meaning to the term Sports Fan by his dedication to the Local sports scene. For decades the man known as "Uncle Bob" to many of Amboy's youth has attended every home sporting event the Amboy Schools and community offered. His voice has been the quite force cheering on generations of Amboy athletes. Amboy High School recognized Bob for his dedication and support of Amboy sports by naming him 1997 Grand Marshall of the Homecoming Parade. The school district also presented him with a lifetime pass to all Amboy Sporting events. For years Bob has also been an active bike rider. He was a familiar sight every morning on his 5 mile bike ride.

He then would walk around town to visit friends at city hall and Don's Barbershop. His loyalty to the Chicago Cubs was legendary. Bob spent his summer vacation time attending many Cub's games. He was a life long fan. Funeral services will be held on Monday June 26,, 2006 beginning with a 10:00 AM prayer service in the Mihm-Jones Funeral Home in Amboy followed by a 10:30 AM Mass of Christian Burial at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Amboy with the Rev. Aaron Brodeski pastor officiating. Burial will follow at St. Patrick Cemetery with military honors by the Amboy American Legion. Visitation will be on Sunday from 2:00 to 6:00 PM in the Funeral Home with the Rosary at 5:00 PM. Memorials had been established to Hospice of the Rock River Valley and Amboy Youth Sports.
