November 8, 1962 - July 27, 2011

Robert R. Sensenig, age 48, of Dixon, died Wednesday July 27, 2011 at Northwestern Memorial Hospital in Chicago. He was born November 8, 1962, in Amboy, the son of Elmer and Evelyn D. (Reubin) Sensenig. He was a shipment coordinator for Woods Equipment Manufacturing in Oregon for over 20 years. He was a member of St. Patrick Catholic Church in Dixon, where he served as a Eucharistic Minister. He was a member of the Dixon Knights of Columbus Council #690 and the Father Boland Assembly Fourth Degree. He was an avid fisherman and coached the 2010 Newman High School State Qualifying Bass Fishing Team. He married Betty Noyes in Dixon May 7, 1983. He was preceded in death by his father. He is survived by his wife of Dixon; 1 son Austin Sensenig of Dixon; mother Dorene Sensenig of Amboy; sisters Marsha Sensenig of Dixon and Tammy (Jeff) Bryant of Amboy.
