Robert D. Welty, age 85 of Amboy, died Monday January 21, 2008 at KSB Hospital in Dixon. He was born April 30, 1922 in Polo, Illinois the son of Day and Olive (Bloyer) Welty.

He had owned and operated Welty Grain and Lumber in Harmon and had also worked as a highway maintainer for the Illinois Department of Transportation for 17 years prior to his retirement.

He was a past member of the First Baptist Church in Dixon where he served as a deacon and counselor. He was currently a member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Amboy.

He was a veteran of the Army Air Corps during World War II. He was a member of the Amboy American Legion and a past member of the Amboy School Board.

He was united in marriage to Mary L. Sitter in Dixon January 2, 1942.

He was preceded in death by 1 sister Doris Welty; son-in-law John Anderson.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday January 24, 2008 at 10:30 AM in the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Amboy with the Rev. Christine Stienstra and Pastor Vicki Sauter co-officiating. Burial will follow in Chapel Hill Memorial Gardens in Dixon with military graveside rites by the Amboy American Legion.

Visitation will be held on Wednesday January 23, from 3:00 until 7:00 PM in the Mihm-Jones Funeral Home in Amboy and also on Thursday from 9:30 until 10:30 AM in the church. A memorial has been established to the Immanuel Lutheran Church and Clipper Kiddies Preschool.
