Rosalind Brown Wakem died on Wednesday, February 25, 2015, at her home in Grand Detour, IL, after a two year struggle with cancer. She worked for many years in advertising and retired from FCB/True North Communications in 1998. A gracious hostess, excellent chef, fine seamstress, and engaging artist, Rosalind was a patron of the arts and generous donor to the Lyric Opera, the Chicago Symphony Orchestra, the Rockford Symphony Orchestra, and Northwestern Medical Center.
