August 11, 1925 - May 6, 2010

Rosanne Edwards age 84 of Dixon died Thursday May 6, 2010 at Heritage Square Health Center in Dixon. She was born Aug. 11, 1925 in Aurora, IL the daughter of Frank and Rosanne (Cunningham) Deutsch. She married Donald Edwards MD June 14, 1951 at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Dixon. She was a 1946 graduate of St. Charles Hospital School of Nursing in Aurora and did post graduate work at Chicago Lying-In Hospital. She had been employed as a registered nurse at KSB Hospital in Dixon and at the Carle Clinic in Champaign, IL. She had taught at the KSB School of Nursing and was Director of Nursing at the Franklin Grove Nursing Center for 14 years prior to her retirement. She had twice been employed by the United States Census Bureau as a census taker. She was a member of St. Patrick Catholic Church in Dixon and volunteered at Sinnissippi Mental Health Center, St. Mary's Grade School and Dixon High School. She also had been active in the Dixon Community Players. She was preceded in death by her parents and a son Jude. She is survived by her husband Donald Edwards MD of Dixon, children Theresa (Mark) Allen of Batavia, IL, Catherine (Bruce) Hill of Dove Creek, Colo., James T (Stephani McDaniel) Edwards of Chicago, grandchildren Esther, Julie, Nancy, and Hilary Allen, 1 sister Junemarie Zinnen of Dixon and several nieces and nephews. Funeral services will be held Tuesday May 11, 2010 beginning with a 10:00 prayer service at the Jones Funeral Home in Dixon followed by a 10:30AM Mass of Christian Burial at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Dixon with the Rev. James Keenan

officiating. Burial will follow at Oakwood Cemetery. Visitation will be on Monday from 2:00 to 4:00 and 6:00 to 8:00 PM in the funeral home with the Rosary at 7:30 PM. A memorial has been established to KSB Hospital in Dixon.
