



## Saeed A Salick

December 24, 1940 - May 5, 2016

Saeed A. Salick age 75 of Dixon passed away Thursday May 5, 2016 at his home after a short battle with cancer. He was born December 24, 1940 in Lahore, India (now Pakistan), the son of Walter and Victoria Salick.

Saeed was a Civil Engineer and worked for the Illinois Department of Transportation for 32 years before retiring in December of 2002. He was very much involved in the photography business in his free time. He enjoyed gardening and outdoor life. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Dixon.
