Sally A. Campbell, 89, of Dixon, Illinois, passed away peacefully on December 25, 2025, at Heritage Square, surrounded by her family.

She was born on October 7, 1936, in Dixon, Illinois, to Robert and Alice (Welch) Hill. Sally was the second eldest of four children and is survived by her sister, Joan Swegle, and her brother, Robert “Bob” Hill. Sally was 1956 graduate of Dixon High School.
