



## Shirley Arlene Pitzer

March 10, 1935 - January 7, 2018

Shirley A. Pitzer, age 82, of Amboy, died Sunday, January 7, 2018, at Mendota Lutheran Home, surrounded by her family. She was born March 10, 1935, in Amboy, the daughter of Marvin and Beulah (Conderman) Miller. Shirley was a Teacher's Aid for Amboy CUSD #272, and had also worked at the Credit Bureau in Dixon prior to her retirement. She made draperies for Kline's Dept Store in Dixon and upholstered furniture, as well as baking and decorating cakes.

She was a member of United First Church in Amboy, and was the Secretary for Prairie Repose Cemetery Board.

Shirley married Charles Pitzer at United Methodist Church in Amboy on May 1, 1955. He preceded her in death April 2, 2010.
