Terry L. Hintz, age 67, of Amboy, died Friday, January 8, 2016, at KSB Hospital in Dixon. She was born in Dixon on September 5, 1948, the daughter of Lloyd and Arlene (Portner) Engle.

She had worked at Mapleside Manor, O'Connell's Yogi Bear Campground both in Amboy and had also worked concession trailers at carnivals and fairs in the area for 20 years.

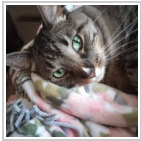
