Thomas F. "Tucker" Butler Jr., age 69 of Dixon died Tuesday October 30, 2007 at Lee County Nursing and Rehab Center in Dixon. He was born in Chicago, Illinois December 9, 1937 the son of Thomas and Dielia (McLaughlin) Butler.
