



Valery "Larry" Leffelman

November 30, 1938 - May 14, 2024

Valery C. "Larry" Leffelman; age 85 of Sublette, died Tuesday May 14, 2024 at his home surrounded by his family. He was born November 30, 1938 in Sublette, the son of Charles and Mildred (Kuebel) Leffelman. Larry was an insurance agent and owned and operated Leffelman & Associates, Inc. since 1969. He was a veteran of the Army National Guard and a 50-year member and past commander of the Amboy American Legion Post. Larry was a member of Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church in Sublette where he had been a religious education teacher. He was a member and past president of the Independent Farm Insurance Agents of Illinois as well as a member of the Independent Insurance Agents of Illinois. Larry was village president of Sublette for 11 years and had been a member of the Mendota Knights of Columbus Council and the Mendota Elks Lodge. He felt very blessed and was passionate about God and his family, community, and country. He had a legendary and unforgettable personality (Larry, the legend - "you're just saying that because it's true") Larry married Rose Ella Bonnell on May 27, 1961 at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church in Sublette. He is survived by his wife Rose, daughters Jennifer (Brad) Considine of Geneva, Christine (Ed) Klein of Sublette, Amy (Gerry) Staszewski of Hampshire, 11 grandchildren: Christian Considine, Emily Considine, Andrew Considine, Grant Considine, Nathan Klein, Valery Klein, Alexandra (Roger) Willey, Riley (Whitney) Klein, Grace Klein, Clayton Staszewski and Aaron Staszewski. He is also survived by one sister Diane (Jim) Flaherty of Mendota. Larry was

preceded in death by his parents and one brother, Eugene Leffelman. Funeral services will be held on Monday, May 20, 2024 at 11:00 AM at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church in Sublette with Rev. Randy Fronck officiating. Burial will follow with military honors by the Amboy American Legion at St. Mary Cemetery in Sublette. I always loved sharing with them pictures of the kids growing up. And Larry would always ask “how’s the Ford garage doing”, and always ask how Jared and I were doing. He was just the greatest, just always making me laugh and just really intrigued, always listened. Such a great fatherly figure to me, and I will truly miss him very much. He

definitely will always have a place in my heart forever and always, and so thankful that I got the privilege to meet such a stand up guy for the time that I lived in Sublette, and for all of my visits that I am thankful for. I pray for Rose and to know that Larry is in good hands and resting in peace with our good Lord above, and he will always be looking down on us. I am forever grateful for the time and precious moments that I can instill and keep forever in my heart. Rest in peace dear Larry, we love you!
