Walter B. Miller Jr., 74, of Dixon, was born June 15, 1943 in Brownsville, TN, to Walter B. Sr. and Corine (Shaw) Miller. He worked at Northwestern Steel and Wire in Sterling for over 30 years prior to his retirement.

Walter married the love of his life Cora Mae Huffman on Sept. 13, 1963 in Cambridge, IL. They spent 54 wonderful years together. To this union, three children were born whom he dearly loved: Wilma, Wallace and Wanda. Walter and Cora's hobby together was fishing. Any free time they had, they would grab their fishing poles and head for a canal!
