February 21, 1924 - September 9, 2013

Wanda M. Steder, age 89, of Amboy, died Monday September 9, 2013 at Franklin Grove Living and Rehabilitation Center. She was born February 21, 1924, in Brown County, Indiana the daughter of Lewis and Alta (Galyan) Masters.
