Wayne B Hoyle age 37 of Dixon died Wednesday Dec. 14, 2011 at Loyola University Medical Center in Maywood. He was born Dec. 4, 1974 in Dixon the son of Joseph and Ellen (McKnight) Hoyle. Wayne was a running back for the 1992 Dixon High School football team and set the record for most yards rushing in a single game with 282.
