Wayne H. Weidman 85, Amboy, Ill died Tuesday November 8, 2005 in his home He was born in Nachusa. Ill the son of Frank and Eva (Spangler) Weidman. He had been employed by the Green River Ordinance Plant prior to entering the Navy. He served from 1944 until 1946. After he returned he was the manager of Lee County Cold Storage in Amboy for 43 years prior to his retirement. He was a member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Amboy, a charter member of the Shady Oaks Country Club, and the Amboy American Legion. He was also a Lifetime Member of the Amboy Volunteer Fire Department. He coached Little League Baseball in Amboy for many years.
