Wesley A. Shippert, age 58 of Dixon passed away unexpectedly on Saturday, August 11, 2007 with his family by his side at St. Anthony Medical Center OSF due to complications of heart disease.

He was born in Dixon on May 25, 1949 the son of Arthur H. and Ruth G. (Fulfs) Shippert. He was a graduate of Dixon High School and attended Sauk Valley Community College. He married Diana K. Nelson March 16, 1980.

He was a member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Amboy.

Wes was a life long fifth generation farmer, former DeKalb seed dealer, served on the Lee County 4-H Center Board, former director and treasurer off the Lee County Soil and Water Conservation district, member of Living History Antique Equipment Association, currently a South Dixon township trustee, member of the Lee County Farm Bureau and Board Member at the Polo Cooperative Association. His interests included restoration of antique farm equipment along with coaching and watching his sons' numerous athletic activities.

He was preceded in death by his parents; grandparents; many aunts and uncles.

He is survived by his wife Diana of Dixon; sons Dr. Brian W. Shippert of Pittsburgh, PA with fiancée Dr. Michelle N. Stalter and Bradley N. Shippert of Dixon with girlfriend Erin M. Yard; 1 sister Marilyn E. Shippert of Dixon.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, August 15 2007 at 10:00 AM in the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Amboy with the Rev. Christine Stienstra and pastor Vicki Sauter co-officiating. Burial will follow in DeWolf Cemetery.
