



William Lawrence Schmidt

March 22, 1939 - January 14, 2014

William L. "Bill" Schmidt, age 74, of Dixon, and formerly of the Quad Cities area, died Tuesday January 14, 2014, at KSB Hospital in Dixon. He was born March 22, 1939, in Morris, Illinois, the son of Hugo and Lois (Yuppie) Schmidt. He worked at Boynton Richards Clothing Store in Dixon and then for 49 years with Marshall Salon Services.

He was a Veteran of the Army.

Bill married Patricia Schultz at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Amboy October 7, 1967.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a brother Edward Schmidt.

Survivors include his wife; 2 sons William P. Schmidt of Des Moines, IA, and Mark Schmidt of Montrose, CO; 1 daughter Sheila Smeltzer of Shallotte, NC; 2 granddaughters Sadie and Isabelle Smeltzer; 3 brothers James (Julia) Schmidt of Morrison, CO, Thomas (Maureen) Schmidt of Dixon, and David (Patricia) Schmidt of Dixon.

Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated on Saturday, January 18, 2014, at 10:30 AM in St. Patrick Catholic Church in Amboy with the Rev. Msgr. Thomas Bales, Pastor, officiating. Burial will follow in St. Patrick Cemetery in Amboy with military graveside rites by the Amboy American Legion. Visitation will be held on Friday, January 17, from 3:00 until 8:00 PM in the Jones Funeral Home in Dixon with a scripture service held at 7:30 PM.
